# TECHNICAL RIDER

**JOURNEY REVISITED** is a 5-piece rock concert show that includes a drummer, a bass player, a guitarist, a keyboardist, and a lead vocalist.

# **SOUND SYSTEM**

Journey Revisited requires a professional, high definition sound reinforcement system. This system shall be in proper working order and free of noise or distortion. The system should be adequate to cover the entire audience with sound levels appropriate for a rock concert. We will need a minimum of eighteen (18) channels. (Please see attached stage plot for input list.)

# STAGE MONITORS

Six (6) monitors with an individual mix for each is preferred, however we can work with six (6) monitors and four (4) monitor mixes, if this is what is available.

# MICS / STANDS / DIRECT-BOXES

- At least seven (7) mics for drums, including appropriate boom stands and micclips.
- Three (3) vocal mics (SM58 or equiv) with boom stands for keyboards, guitarist and bassvocals.
- One (1) vocal mics (SM58 or equiv) cordless for lead vocalist.
- One (1) Direct box for Bass amp
- One (1) Direct boxes for Guitars
- Two (1) Direct boxes for Keyboards
- One (1) Guitar rack

#### LIGHTING REQUIREMENTS

General stage lighting, with color washes (no green on performers, please) and soloist spots for lead vocalist, guitarists.

# STAGE EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS - MISC.

Four (4) A/C power quad boxes for stage backline power only

# **BACKLINE REQUIREMENTS – ONLY WHEN CONTRACTED**

#### **DRUMS**

Professional level drum set. Prefer Yamaha. Tama, Pearl, DW etc all fine Preferred kick drum size is 22" If available preferred tom sizes are 10, 12, 13 rack toms. 16 and 18 floor toms. If those sizes aren't available, then 8, 10, 12 rack toms. 14 and 16 floor toms Preferred snare drum is Ludwig 402 Supraphonic 6.5 x 14. If not available, another professional level snare drum 6 x 14 or 6.5 x 14. Prefer Zildjian cymbals in larger sizes Ride = 22" if available.

4 crashes. Sizes ranging from 17"-20". Thin or medium thin preferred Hi hats = 14"

China cymbal = 20" if available. If not, 18". Prefer "swish" or 'china boy low" All necessary accompanying drum hardware for drums and cymbals Professional drum throne

Double pedal (Iron cobra, DW 5000 or 9000, Pearl Eliminator etc) Drum rug/carpet Drum key
